# March 29, 2025 Service Change

Changes to Community Transit bus service start on March 29. These changes are made with riders in mind, helping to create more reliable service, improved connections, and more options for trips.

# Route 120: Lynnwood City Center Station – UW Bothell/Cascadia College

Route 120 will change in Lynnwood. From Damson Rd, the route will travel on Logan Rd and follow it around to 4th Ave. Some stops will be removed, and stops will be added.

Route 120 will have more frequent bus service during weekdays, and one earlier a.m. trip on Sundays.

# Route 202: Smokey Point Transit Center – Lynnwood City Center Station

Route 202 will change in Arlington. From 51st Ave, the route will travel on 168th St, go around the Amazon Fulfillment Center, and continue the same path to the Smokey Point Transit Center.

A pair of new bus stops will be added between Walmart and Amazon. No bus stops will be removed.

Most Community Transit bus routes will have schedule changes. All riders should check their schedule for updates.





# Route 209: Smokey Point Transit Center – Lake Stevens Transit Center

Route 209 will change in Marysville. From Hwy 9, the route will travel on Soper Hill Rd and 83rd Ave. It will then turn on to 64th St NE, and continue the same path through Marysville.

The bus stops near Walmart will be moved west along 64th Street. There will be new stops along this section of the route and a small number of existing stops will be removed.



# Route 220: Arlington – Smokey Point Transit Center

Route 220 will change in Arlington. From Broadway, the route will extend north and travel on Burke Ave and Haller Ave, with a new stop near Grocery Outlet.

Route 220 will have earlier trips in the mornings on weekdays and later trips in the p.m. on weekdays and Saturdays.

Most Community Transit bus routes will have schedule changes. All riders should check their schedule for updates.

#### Route 270: Gold Bar – Everett Station

Route 270 will no longer travel to Seaway Transit Center. Route 270 riders can transfer to Route 907 at Everett Station Bay B1 to travel to Seaway Transit Center. This route will have an earlier a.m. trip and later p.m. trip on weekdays.

## Route 271: Gold Bar – Everett Station

Route 271 will no longer travel to Seaway Transit Center. Route 271 riders can transfer to Route 907 at Everett Station Bay B1 to travel to Seaway Transit Center.

## Route 280: Lake Stevens/Granite Falls Park & Ride – Everett Station

Route 280 will no longer travel to Seaway Transit Center. Route 280 riders can transfer to Route 907 at Everett Station Bay B1 to travel to Seaway Transit Center. This route will also have more frequent service during peak a.m. and p.m. travel hours on weekdays.

#### Route 907: Stanwood I-5 Park & Ride – Seaway Transit Center

Route 907 will include stops in downtown Everett and Everett Station. Riders of Routes 270, 271, and 280 can transfer to Route 907 at Everett Station Bay B1 to travel to Seaway Transit Center.
